Montessori STARS is a blended teaching of Maria Montessori, woven together with the freedom and exploration of Free Play, under the guidance of our;

Early Childhood Curriculum, Te Whāriki.

Our Philosophy guides and inspires our teaching and learning as we aim for all tamariki to develop to their full potential.

It is founded on three core values of Relationships/Ngā Hononga, Respect/ Whakaute, and Learning/Ako, and it is through these values that we honour our obligations under Te Tiriti o Waitangi.

We allow the time and space for every child to grow and learn in ways that are meaningful to them and their families.

We believe that each child is unique, teaching with inclusion, respect for individuality within the diverse range of cultures and ways of being present at **Montessori STARS.**

Our practice is founded on collaborative, responsive relationships, underpinned by communication, and bound in Aroha.

These relationships encourage integrity in our actions, and foster respect for ones self, for others, and for the things around us, both living and material.

OUR CURRICULUM IS DEVELOPED FROM THREE CRITICAL COMPONENTS

<u>Montessori</u>

Montessori Education is a method and philosophy based on years of observation and work with children by Dr Maria Montessori, Italian doctor, and educator.

The Montessori approach begins with the acknowledged potential of each child and provides for physical, cognitive, and spiritual development through a prepared environment. With specialised equipment and qualified teachers that nurture independence, concentration, co-operation, and respect while focusing on each child's unique learning style and encouraging the child's own natural desire to learn.

Te Whāriki (English translation: "the mat")

This is the National Curriculum for Early Childhood Education. Unique in its bicultural framing, Te Whāriki expresses the vision that all children grow up in New Zealand as competent and confident learners, strong in their identity, language, and culture. It emphasises our bicultural foundation, our multi-cultural presence and diversity, and the shared future we are creating.

It implements a programme of learning and development that encourages and supports each child's personalised learning pathway alongside adults who know them well and have their best interests at heart.

The underpinning concept of the whāriki (mat) enables and supports this diversity.

Emergent Curriculum

This part of the curriculum is based on children's interests, learning styles and dispositions. Through observation, our skilled teachers notice and record children's activity choices and interests and plan ways to extend and develop these further. This allows children the opportunity to gain independence and direct their own learning.

Classroom

Our Montessori classroom is very orderly, it is a child-sized world where order allows children to choose their own work and return it neatly to the shelf once completed. Children work with materials independently, with their peers or with a teacher. Adults treat children with respect and understanding, encouraging independence, whilst building their self-confidence and self-esteem.

Our focus is on the whole child and choices of activities are carefully selected to provide interest, variety, and necessary learning experiences.

Coordination, manners, respect for others and self are fostered, increasing your child's social skills and awareness.

Presentation of Montessori Equipment

Our teachers give children presentations on materials that they have not used before, so they understand their purpose. It is vital that children engage in a cycle of repetition allowing them time to grasp the concepts that the materials are teaching them.

Each activity a child works with is the preparation for the activity that follows later, and each activity has an extension.



Key Teacher

Every child is allocated a key teacher who will, alongside our team, monitor your child's progress. Please feel free to talk to any teacher regarding your child. The more informed we are about what is happening for your child on each day they arrive at Montessori STARS, the better equipped we are to meet their needs and interests. We know that every child is an individual and we respect that you know your child better than anyone.

Transition to School

We provide experiences and opportunities for your child to build on their educational, social and emotional and practical skills. After consultation with teachers in the primary sector we recognise that these are vital skills for children to learn in preparation for their Kura/School and future life.

Assessment / Educa

Every child will have documentation in the form of Learning Stories on our Educa online system that are uploaded for you to view any time.

These stories show what your child's interests, learning style and developmental areas are so you can see how your child's having fun through learning all day long. This specialised tool offers each child an individual profile that can be accessed by parents 24/7 including extended family via a password login.

We urge you to view your child's profile at your leisure and have input into this on a regular basis. The more we hear your voice and your child's, the more informed and equipped we are to meet your child's needs and interest levels. There is also a centre dashboard where notices will be posted about upcoming events and any other general information about what is happening here at Montessori STARS.

Partnership with Parents/Whānau

We strongly believe in building partnerships with families, and we will try to share as much information as possible during the day. This can be challenging during sessions so if you would like to catch up with us, please do not hesitate to let teachers know and we will make a time that suits you. We believe in teachers and parents working together to give your child the best possible start. We encourage a collaborative approach to education and value your input and support.

Enrolment Procedure

Parents who are interested in their child attending Montessori STARS are welcome to come and observe at any time with our open-door policy. A one-off, nonrefundable enrolment fee of \$100.00 is payable when enrolling your child and must be received before a child can be placed on the waiting list. This will be used for your child's profile book, sunscreen, a hat and to secure your child's enrolment. This will be confirmed when we have the enrolment form completed and signed. Please remember to bring with you a copy or screenshot of all additional documents required including - Immunisations, Birth Certificate or Passport.

Please talk to our team about the sessions you prefer.

Work and Income Subsidy

Generous subsidies are available with eligibility depending on your personal income. To be eligible all families must register with Work and Income NZ(WINZ). Please feel free to ask us for the forms or you can visit <u>www.workandincome.co.nz</u>.

Fees, 20 Hours ECE and Donations

Montessori STARS provides education and care at a higher level than required by the Ministry of Education. We are a small family focused preschool with high teacher ratio's and a total roll of 24 children. Montessori Education is additional to the New Zealand Early Childhood Curriculum therefore we ask for a voluntary donation of \$10.00 per day from all those who use their 20 hours ECE. All hours over 6hrs per day and 20 hrs per week are charged at \$12.00 per hour. All fees are inclusive of GST at 15%

Please note: All booking changes require 4 weeks notice and must be given in writing to Sharon at montessoristars2017@gmail.com.

Late Fee and Notice of Withdrawal

If you are going to be late for your child's pick-up time, please ring ahead to inform our team. A late fee of \$1.00 per minute will be charged, after 4.00pm. We require four weeks written notice of intention to withdraw your child, or full fees will apply.

Invoices and Payments

Invoices are emailed on a Monday every week and must be paid upon receipt.

Please set up an automatic payment for all fees owing and ensure your child's name follows for our reference. Our bank account details are printed at the bottom of your invoice. If your account becomes overdue for more than 4 weeks, we will refer it to a collection agency and all incurred charges will be your responsibility. This may also result in the cancellation of your child's enrolment at Montessori STARS.

Holidays

Children can have a maximum of 2 weeks holiday per year at 50% (of their regular weekly bookings). Please fill in a holiday form or email montessoristars2017@gmail.com 2 weeks prior for all holidays. If your child has more than 3 weeks of consecutive absence the Ministry of Education will stop funding for your child and full fees will apply.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Once you have enrolled your child, the following information will be helpful to ensure a smooth transition and settling period.

First Day

Our team will be available to go through the settling routines with you. Sign in and get your child to look for their name tag on the tray next to the cubbies. Place lunch boxes on the shelves next to the name tags.

Place your bag in any of the cubbies to your left and put your name tag on the magnet next to your bag.

We do encourage you to let your child go through this process independently, when they are able to.

You are welcome to stay until you feel comfortable to leave. Ensure to communicate with our team throughout this time, for advice and support. Feel free to ring us at any time to see how your child is and be assured that we will call you if your child is unhappy.

<u>Please put in your child's bag</u> - A spare set of clothing and jacket.

Please provide all nappies and wipes and clearly name all your child's belongings. If your child requires nappy cream, medications etc. please give these to a teacher who will complete a medication form which must be signed by a parent.

<u>Allergies/Medication</u> - Please inform our team of any allergies or medication so we can meet your child's needs appropriately.

We will require you to fill in a medication form and you will be asked to sign this form again when you take the medication off the premises.

For long term medicines, i.e., Ventolin or EpiPen a personalised medicine form needs to be completed, signed and training given by you with an additional training form completed and signed.

This will document what, how and when the medicine should be given, and needs to be renewed every 3 months, or when your circumstances change.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL MEDICATIONS, ETC, ARE HANDED TO A TEACHER AND SIGNED FOR.

First Aid - We endeavour to make our environment as safe as possible.

In the event of an injury, one of our team who holds a current comprehensive first aid certificate, will attend to your child. If an injury is more serious, we will contact you and/ or act in the best interests for your child's safety.

For safety reasons, plasters will cover all blood, arnica cream and ice packs will be applied to any bruise where necessary.

There is information on our enrolment form to indicate if for any reason you would prefer us not to do this.

All injuries/illnesses and incidents will be documented and explained to you, and you will be required to sign the injury/illness and incident register to acknowledge that you have been informed. <u>Sun Safety</u> - We provide every child with a named sunhat to stay at <u>Montessori STARS</u>. You can also purchase an extra sunhat for \$12.00 to keep for your private use. T-Shirts can be purchased for \$10.00 each.

Please apply sunblock to your child prior to coming to preschool and we will reapply this at lunch time.

<u>Food</u> - In the preparation for Kura/ Primary School we believe in all children having their own named lunch box to include lunch, morning, and afternoon tea. Please bring a named drink bottle and place in the drink bottle holder. As part of our programme, we encourage children to make healthy food choices and would appreciate it if you could provide healthy lunches. Please no chocolate or sweets, all children have access to water all day.

Due to allergies at Montessori STARS we are a NUT FREE ZONE.

<u>Celebrations</u> - We celebrate every child's Birthday and Graduation last day at <u>Montessori</u> STARS with a globe ceremony and the children sing 'Happy Birthday'. You are more than welcome to join us for this.

To maintain the healthy food messages and to accommodate all children with allergies, you can bring a small wrapped treat that will be given to the child's parent at pick up time e.g. Freddo Frogs or something similar to this that is **nut free please**.

<u>Sleeping</u> - If your child has a special sleep toy or cuddly blanket, please bring this so we can ensure continuity and a comfortable sleep time.

<u>Toileting</u> - Please inform our team of what stage your child is at regarding toileting, so we can meet your child's individual needs.

We will support all toilet training routines that you are practicing at home.

<u>Illness</u> - If your child is unwell, please keep them at home and telephone or message us at <u>Montessori STARS</u> to let us know. The Early Childhood Regulations give the staff the authority to exclude sick children from attending to stop the spread of infection. We ask that you keep your child at home for 48 hours after their last onset of vomiting or diarrhoea.

<u>Hearing and Vision</u> - The Canterbury District Health Board Vision and Hearing Screening Service offer us regular visits for testing. This is for children 3 and 4 years old and you will receive notification from them if there are any concerns.

Emergency Closure - Situations may arise that lead to the emergency closure of **Montessori STARS** preschool. Some events, such as loss of power or water, may lead to the Ministry of Education requiring us to close. On rare occasions extreme weather conditions may also force us to close. In the event of an emergency closure, it will be necessary for you to collect your child as soon as possible.
